Stay: ChangDe Yunxi Hotel or Equivalent

After breakfast, head to **XianTao Dream Water Village** Scenic Area (includes boat ride and electric car) to experience the unique charm of the water town. Then, visit **ChangDe LiuYe Lake**, an eco-park and resort destination named for its willow leaf-shaped lake. Finally, explore **DaXiaHe Street**, a new model of ancient commercial street integrating tourism, leisure, vacation, and residence, known as Changde's "Along the River During the Qingming Festival".

DAY 3 ChangDe – FengHuang – JiShou (Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner) Equivalent

Stay: JiShou FengMing TianXia Hotel or

After breakfast, visit the picturesque **Phoenix Ancient Town** (includes eco-friendly sightseeing car), stroll along the **Stone-Paved Streets** of Fenghuang City, visit **HongQiao Wind and Rain Tower**, and **TiaoYan**, experiencing the rich cultural and historical atmosphere. In the evening, enjoy the **XiangJian Tuojiang River** art night cruise boat, first leisure night boat in China with Miao culture, designed exclusively for Phoenix Ancient Town (includes 2-hour costume experience, makeup and hairstyling not included).

DAY 4 JiShou – ZhangJiaJie (Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner)

Stay: QingHe JinJiang International Hotel or Equivalent

After breakfast, visit **MoRong Miao Village**, "MoRong" meaning "place with dragons" in the Miao language, experiencing the cultural customs of the Chinese ethnic minority village. Then, head to **Junsheng Art Gallery** to appreciate the delicate and beautiful art. Continue to explore **Zhangjiajie National Forest Park**, the first national forest park in China. Afterward visiting **Jinbian Creek** and passing the "ShuiRaoSiMen", formation from four creek walking along the stream with dense scenic spots on both sides, sheer cliffs, and lush mountains. Finally, explore **Ten-Mile Gallery** (includes round-trip small train).

DAY 5 ZhangJiaJie (Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner)

Stay: QingHe JinJiang International Hotel or Equivalent

After breakfast, take a car to **Zhangjiajie Forest Park**. After entering the mountain, take the Bailong Elevator to **YuanJiaJie**, **Soul Bewitching Terrace**, and the real shooting location of the floating mountains in the movie "Avatar," and the "First Bridge in the World," a natural stone slab about 5 meters thick spanning two peaks, known for its height, span, and thrill. After the tour, take the park shuttle to **Tianzi Mountain**, visiting **West Sea Stone Forest**, **Imperial Brush Peak**, **Fairy Scattering Flowers**, and **Stone Boat Out to Sea**, descend by cable car.

**Note: In winter, if roads are icy and park shuttles are suspended for safety reasons, the itinerary will be adjusted accordingly, and some attractions may not be visited. Tianmen Mountain scenery is greatly affected by weather, and the tour mode and attractions may change based on park notifications in winter.*

DAY 6 ZhangJiaJie (Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner)

Stay: Zhangjiajie Western Hotel or Equivalent

After breakfast, we will visit the **TianMen Mountain National Forest Park**, a stunning natural reserve. We will take a one-way cable car ride up the mountain to enjoy the magnificent mountain scenery and sea of clouds. You will also have the opportunity to use the **round-trip escalator and one-way express cable car** to travel between various scenic spots on the mountain, making it convenient to appreciate the beautiful views. Next, you will have the chance to experience the **glass skywalk** (including shoe covers), which allows you to cross cliff edges and walk on transparent glass floors while experiencing thrilling excitement and enjoying breathtaking views. We will also visit the **TianMen Cave**, a magnificent natural rock cave known as the highest natural arch in the world. Afterward, we will visit the **Seventy-Two Scenic Towers**, a towering stilted building reaching a height of 109.9 meters, listed in the Guinness World Records. You will have the opportunity to appreciate the unique charm of this majestic architecture. **Note: The scenery at Tianmen Mountain is subject to weather conditions. During winter, the visitation method and attractions may be subject to changes based on notifications from the scenic area.*

DAY 7 ZhangJiaJie – YueYang (Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner)

Stay: YueYang Hampton by Hilton or Equivalent

After breakfast, visit **Zhangjiajie TuSiCheng**, is an ancient town with complex history, featuring a 48-meter-tall stilted building constructed without a nail, a miracle in Tujia stilted building architecture. Then, drive to YueYang, overlooking **DongTing Lake**, visiting the exterior of **Yueyang Tower**, and **BianHe Street**, a traditional-style commercial street, experiencing the atmosphere of YueYang. **Note: If fly via China Eastern Carrier, will be stayed in Wuhan Hotel*
