DAY 4 OUARZAZATE – TORDA GORGES – MERZUOGA

• Torda Gorges - This natural barrier in the eastern Atlas Mountains is a narrow gorge 10 meters wide and over 300 meters high, offering stunning views of sheer rock walls and a small river at the valley floor. • Sahara Desert - The Sahara here is famous for its unique sand dunes that change colors with the light. Experience the beauty of the desert with a 4x4 off-road vehicle ride and camel ride to view the red sand dunes.

DAY 5 MERZUOGA – IFRANE – FEZ

- Ifrane known as "Little Switzerland" for its skiing and European-like climate. This town, located between the Sahara Desert and Fez, has roots dating back to 500 BC when it was the capital of an ancient Jewish kingdom.
- Fez a major historical Islamic city in North Africa and has been Morocco's religious, cultural, and artistic center for over a thousand years. Surrounded by 5-meter- high brown walls, the old city has over 200 mosques and is renowned for its traditional crafts

DAY 6 **FEZ - CHEFCHAOUEN**

- Bou Jeloud (Blue Gate), and ancient city gate decorated with blue mosaics.
- Chouara Tannery, a colorful aerial palette
- Exterior view Al Quaraouiyine Mosque the second largest mosque and the oldest islamic higher education institution (Non-Muslims are generally not allowed to enter the Al.
- Visit Al Attarine Madrasa one of the most important spiritual centres in Fez and one of the most visited landmarks in the Moroccan city. It was inhabited by numerous scholars and craftsmen and has a very long history and cultural background.
- Exterior view of the **Royal Palace** of Fez
- Chefchaouen Known for its striking blue-washed buildings, narrow alleys adorned with colorful flower pots, and a serene atmosphere, Chefchaouen is often referred to as the "Blue City." It attracts visitors seeking tranquility, beautiful architecture, and a unique cultural experience.
