- Seongsan Ilchulbong Peak (Sunrise Peak) Seongsan Ilchulbong Tuff Cone rose 180 meters above sea level due to a magma flow under the sea over 5,000 years ago. It was originally a separate island, but a build-up of sand and soil has connected it to the main island.
- Seopjikoji Hill Seopjikoji, which is located on the east of Jeju Self-Governing Province, is a beautiful coastline filled with canola flowers during the spring, Seongsan Ilchulbong Peak rising the up background, the and stunning Sinyang Beach nearby.


Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner
