Day 1 Singapore – Incheon – Osaka (Meal on board)

Gather at Singapore Changi Airport for your flight to Osaka, with a layover in Seoul at Incheon Airport. Upon arrival in Osaka, transfer to your hotel and enjoy some leisure time exploring Osaka city.

Day 3 Osaka (Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner)

After breakfast, heading to **Kema Sakuranomiya Park**, where the lush cherry blossoms along the Okawa River create a stunning pink canopy. Next, visit the **Osaka Mint Bureau**, famous for its Sakura Passage, a beautifully lined walkway showcasing over 300 cherry trees in full bloom. Continue to **Osaka Castle Park**, a historic and scenic spot with cherry blossoms, a tower, and a garden. Finally, spend your shopping time and exploring the vibrant streets of **Dotonbori**, where neon lights and lively atmosphere offer a perfect blend of tradition and modernity.

Day 4 Osaka – Seoul (Breakfast)

After breakfast, transfer to Kansai International Airport for your flight to Seoul. Upon arrival at Incheon International Airport, meet your local guide and transfer to your hotel. Spend the rest of the day at leisure, exploring Seoul's vibrant cityscape and settling into your new surroundings.

Day 5 Seoul – Gangwondo - Seoul (Breakfast/Lunch/Jeongsik Dinner)

It typically includes a main dish, such as grilled meat, fish, or a hearty stew, accompanied by an array of side dishes called banchan.

park is adorned with cherry blossoms, adding an enchanting touch to the vibrant atmosphere.
