The place is bustling during the day and night, with various markets, cultural and creative bookstores, traditional snacks. Later, we will visit **CangQiao Old Street**, enjoy the atmosphere of the reality life of the local.

DAY 5 NANXUN – WUXI (Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner) STAY: WUXI HUAYI MINGDU HOTEL OR EQUIVALENT

After breakfast, head to Wuxi. We will visit **Huishan Ancient Town,** is a combination of Jiangnan Garden and Ancient Temples. The various Wuxi snacks on the street are also worth to have a try. Then go to the **Qingming Bridge Historical Street District**, composed of areas with rich historical and cultural heritage such as Nanchang Street, Wuxi Section of the Beijing-Hangzhou Grand Canal, NanXiaTang, Bodu Port, and Dayao Road.

DAY 6 WUXI – SUZHOU (Breakfast/Lunch)

STAY: SNOWY SEA HOTEL YOULIAN OR EQUIVALENT

After breakfast, proceed to Suzhou. First visit the **Lion Grove Garden**, is one of the representatives of classical Chinese private garden architecture and it is located in Suzhou City. Because the garden is filled with numerous stone peaks, many of which resemble lions, it has been named accordingly. Then visit the must-see attraction in Suzhou - **PingJiang Road**, where you can deeply experience the local life and take beautiful photos. Then visit **GuanQian Street**, the local famous snack street offers a rich variety of delicious snacks, allowing visitors to enjoy them while strolling.

DAY 7 SUZHOU – SHANGHAI (Breakfast/Lunch) STAY: CROWNE PLAZA SHANGHAI ANTING HOTEL OR EQUIVALENT

After breakfast, we will go to Shanghai to visit **Nanjing Road**, the most representative commercial district in Shanghai, which is very suitable for shopping and eating. The best photo-taking spots for those who like to take photos of the Oriental Pearl Tower are also interspersed in various streets. Then we will visit the **City God Temple**. Generally speaking, the Shanghai City God Temple refers to the old City God Temple in Huangpu District. The Temple is famous for its long history, magnificent architecture, and a variety of snacks. Then we will go to **The Bund** to experience the different styles of international architecture, appreciate the accumulation of culture, and witness the changes in Shanghai's history.

DAY 8 SHANGHAI >> Singapore (Breakfast)

After breakfast proceed to airport and take a flight back to Singapore.

*Note: If the flight is returning from HangZhou, we will proceed to HangZhou airport.
