# DAY 2 OSAKA (Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner)

# DAY 4 OSAKA – NARA – TOYOHASHI (Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner)

After breakfast, experience hand-feeding of Deers in Nara Sika Deer Park where raised a large number of deer. Then visit the Todaji Temple, the temple is a national treasure of Japan and was listed as a World Heritage site in 1998. Then, take a car to Higashimuki Shopping Street, where you'll find many small Japanese shops. You can also try Nara's must-eat snack, 'Nakatanidou' mochi (Muslim-friendly). Enjoy the relaxed Japanese atmosphere, and after the visit, return to the hotel to rest.

After breakfast, spend your morning at Japan's largest outlet mall Gotemba Outlet.
