# 7D6N Yuk Jalan Jalan Ke **HANOI VIETNAM**





Meals On Board/Dinner

Assemble at Singapore Changi Airport for your flight to Hanoi Vietnam, Arrive Noi Bai International Airport. Warmly welcome by our guide and start a city orientation tour visiting: Al Noor Mosque is the only mosque in the North of Vietnam, at 12 Hang Luoc, Hang Ma, Hoan Kiem, Hanoi. For more than 100 years, Al Noor Mosque has been a weekly prayer destination for local and foreign Muslim believers. The Flag Tower of Hanoi is a tower in Hanoi, Vietnam, which is one of the symbols of the city and once a part of the Hanoi Citadel, a World Heritage Site. Ba Dinh Square is the largest square in Vietnam, with 320m in length, 100m in width, 210 grass plots and capacity of 20,000 people. There is a flag tower of 29m high in the square's center. Nice experience in Hanoi - The Railway Cafe in Hanoi provides a unique and aesthetically pleasing experience with its train views (Drink is on personal account)

# DAY 2 HANOI – SAPA TOWN Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner

After breakfast at hotel then depart to **Sapa by bus**, located at 1500 meters (4921 feet) above sea level in Vietnam's remote northwest mountains. Sapa is famous for both its fine, **rugged scenery** and also its rich **cultural diversity. Sapa** is an incredibly picturesque town that lies in the Hoang Lien Son Mountain range near the Chinese border in northwestern

Vietnam, known as "the Tonkinese Alps". Sapa and its surrounding region is host to many hill tribes, as well as rice terraces, lush vegetation, and Fansipan, the highest peak in Vietnam. The Rose Valley is so beautiful. Visiting valley from March to November in the year, you will be ecstatic to enjoy the scent of blooming roses millions in the morning. In winter, the peach orchards, plum orchards will give you the feeling of traveling in Japan on the occasion of Lunar New Year. Sa Pa Stone Church is located in the centre of Sa Pa Town and considered as the most intact ancient French architectural work in Sa Pa. Sapa stone church built in the cross shape simulation Gothic Roman architecture, shown in the roof, bell tower, arches... with pyramidal shape and windows with colored glass. Café in the Clouds Pull a chair at Café In The Clouds, relax in this great corner of Sapa in which to pause and soak in the valley or, equally often, the wandering mist at eye level. Overnight at Sapa Hotel.

# DAY 3 SAPA – FULL DAY TOUR – FANSIPAN PEAK

Breakfast/Lunch/Traditional Folklore Show Dinner After breakfast proceed to full day **Sapa tour** to visit **Fansipan Peak, Train experience from Sapa City to Fansipan**. **Silver waterfall** - Thac Bac is formed by sources of water from the Lo Sui Tong Mountain peak. From the distance, the waterfall looks like a white dragon looking down from the sky. You can reach the Silver Waterfall by motor bike or by car in half an

hour. From there you can see stunning view of the surrounding mountains and the last forests belonging to Hoang Lien National Park. Sapa Heaven's Gate is a popular destination in Sapa. The arch is so named because it is the highest point of the road Sapa. This is an ideal landscape where visitors can admire the unspoiled beauty of the northwestern mountains along with the spectacular and magnificent natural scenery of Hoang Lien Mountain Range. Fansipan for an amazing trip to reach the Indochina Roof, 3143m above the sea level: Starting by cable car and step up to the Peak, enjoy the fresh air and the beautiful landscapes from the high. Take the 20 minute cable car journey and enjoy the spectacular scenery. Afterwards, spend some time enjoying the view and taking some photos at an altitude of 2800 meters. Visit Pagoda the spiritual destinations and climb the 600 steps to the peak of Fansipan, the highest Peak in Vietnam. Embark on a lovely walking tour that will take you along buffalo paths and trails and through several hill tribe villages of Lao Cai Province, especially Ta Van home to the Black H'mong and Dzay people. This is an absolutely spectacular walk through stunning scenery inhabited by some of the friendliest people you can meet. Once on the valley floor you can really appreciate the wonderful scenery surrounding you. The walls of the valley are covered with multi-layered rice terraced fields. Ta Phin Village - Set within the valley with a towering mountain peak on the other end, this village is bustling with the daily life of the Kinh, Red Dzao and Black Hmong. Overnight at Sapa Hotel.

## DAY 4 SAPA - HANOI Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner

Today, visit to Vietnam - China border photo taking: there is a nice park that overlooks the Red River. To the left is China, and to the right is Vietnam. Den Thuong Pagoda is a zodiac circle featuring the animals of the lunar calendar. The temple has one of the most amazing temple trees you will see anywhere. It's time to say "Good bye Sa Pa!" and drive back to Hanoi. Along the way, once again you have a chance to enjoy the magical beauty of northwest mountains. Upon arrival Hanoi and explore **Dong Xuan market**. Overnight at Hanoi Hotel.

## DAY 5 **HANOI - HALONG BAY**

Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner

07:45: Pick up from Hanoi for a four-hour drive through to Halong Bay 11.30 - 12.00 Arrival at Ha Long international harbor

12.15 - 12.30 Transfer to cruise ship Welcome Drink - cruise briefing, safety instructions, check-in cabins - Depart to Halong Bay

13.00 - 14.30 Enjoy local seafood at set lunch while the junk sails to Ha Long Bay passing by Oan Lagoon, Mat Quy (Monster head) and Am tich (Teapot) Islets 15:00 Transfer to Luon Lagoon. We can kayaking here or sitting on bamboo boat, rowers are local girls wearing traditional costume.

17:00 Transfer to Titop island, Relaxing, swimming... in the clear water, beautiful and calm nature.

18.00 Anchor for overnight 18.30 Sunset party and cooking show 19.30 – 21.00 Savor a delicious buffet/set -dinner in dining room

21.00 - 23.00 Activities: Relax on deck, Beauty Spa services, drink service available or night time fishing. Overnight on Halong Bay Cruise (5\*)
