

















# 8D MACAU, HONG KONG & SHENZHEN With OLI 968 DJ Neruppu Guna





Assemble at Singapore Changi Airport for your flight to **Macau**, known as the Las Vegas of Asia. Upon arrival, check in to the hotel.



Breakfast/Lunch/ Dinner

After breakfast, embark on a walking tour of the old town where you will pass by stalls selling famous local foods and



desserts. Enjoy a complimentary Portuguese egg tart and you may wish to try other local snacks at your own expense. Visit Ruins of St Paul's, a symbolic icon of Macau. It features a mannerist style with distinctively oriental decorative motifs spanning 23 metres in width and 25.5 metres in height. Thereafter, proceed to Mt Fortress, built in the 16th century, which served as the city's principal military defence. It is shaped like a trapezoid with bulwarks protruding from its 4 corners. Stroll along Senado Square, surrounded by pastel-coloured neoclassical buildings with a Mediterranean ambience. Explore St Dominic's Church and Leal Senado

> Thereafter, head to the Kun lam **Ecumenical Centre.** The Goddess of Mercy statue stands 20 metres in height and is made of a special bronze, with a dome-shaped base resembling a lotus flower. After lunch, proceed to Rua do Cunha, a narrow bustling pedestrian street built in the early

19th century. It is a

popular spot for shops selling local snacks and souvenirs. This evening, indulge in European ambience and snap photos at The Londoner Macao and The Venetian Macao, and be dazzled by **Eiffel Tower Grand Illumination Show** at The Parisian Macao.

## DAY 3 Macau – HONG KONG Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner

After breakfast, head to Hong Kong crossing Hong Kong - Zhuhai - Macau Bridge, the longest bridge-cum-tunnel sea crossing in the world spanning 55 kilometres. After lunch, proceed to Avenue of Stars, a promenade along Tsim Sha Tsui's southern waterfront. Walk along the extended walkway featuring a railing mirroring the waves with celebrity handprints on display. Explore Clock **Tower**, a memorable landmark that was once part of Kowloon-Canton Railway. Next, stroll along Repulse Bay and enjoy the sea view. Visit 1881 Heritage which once served as the headquarters of the Hong Kong Marine Police. Several historical buildings and artefacts have been preserved and restored and the site now features a shopping mall, heritage hotel and an exhibition hall. Enjoy a bird's-eye view of Hong Kong's iconic skyline at The Peak.

### DAY 4 **HONG KONG**

Today, enjoy your day at Hong Kong Disneyland, a favourite for both adults and kids. Explore the 7 themed areas, each offering unique attractions and experiences. Do not miss the parades and live shows featuring beloved Disney characters. The Momentous Nighttime Spectacular show is a highlight, combining fireworks, music and projections for an unforgettable experience.

### DAY 5 **HONG KONG -SHENZHEN**

Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner

After breakfast, coach to Shenzhen, China's first special economic zone and the first city in the country to be designated a City of Creative Design by UNESCO. Visit OH Bay, located along the northern coastline of Qianhai Bay. Take a picture with the iconic Bay Glory Ferris wheel or enjoy a Ferris wheel ride for a stunning seascape view at your own expense. Visit Shenzhen Zhongshuge bookstore known for its spiralling sculptural bookshelves that create a visually mesmerising experience. After lunch, head to Shenzhen Museum, the first cultural museum in Shenzhen. This large-scale museum integrates collection, preservation, research, display and education, providing a comprehensive insight into the city's history and culture. Thereafter, proceed to Window of the World, offering a unique opportunity to see replicas of famous landmarks from around the world in one place. The park is divided into 9 scenic areas featuring 118 magnificent attractions, replicated at a scale of 1:1 or 1:1.5. The replicas include the pyramids of Egypt, Paris' Arc de Triomphe, India's Taj Mahal and Italy's Leaning Tower of Pisa.



Breakfast/Lunch/Get-Together Dinner

This morning, visit **Dafen Oil Painting Village**, home to artists who have been producing near-perfect copies of original art for years. After lunch, head to Dongmen Pedestrian Street, a vibrant

hub for tourists, offering a plethora of shopping malls, popular eateries, unique stores and street performers. Thereafter, enjoy shopping at **Luohu Commercial** City which houses 1260 shops offering a diverse collection of goods. Tonight, enjoy a get-together dinner.

### DAY 7 SHENZHEN - MACAU Breakfast/Lunch

After breakfast, indulge in gadget and technology shopping at

Huaqiangbei, renowned as China's number one electronics street. After lunch, transfer to the terminal for your **ferry ride** to Macau. Spend the rest of the day at leisure. You can choose to explore Galaxy Macau, a world-class luxury integrated resort offering a variety of dining and shopping options. Enjoy Galaxy Macau Diamond Show where dazzling lights, sound, water and visual artistry come together or join an open-top bus tour, providing a unique perspective of Macau's vibrant nightlife and iconic landmarks, at your own expense.
