Day 1 SINGAPORE - TAIPEI

Upon arrival, transfer to Taoyuan hotel and free at leisure.

Day 2 TAIPEI (Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner)

After enjoying your breakfast, our journey begins with a transfer to **Heping Island Park**, located just off the coast of Keelung. This coastal park offers scenic ocean views and unique rock formations, providing a tranquil ambiance perfect for morning exploration. Next, we travel to **Jiufen**. Jiufen is a place where history and culture come alive. As you wander through the town, you'll be captivated by the beautiful views of the Pacific Ocean and the nostalgic atmosphere reminiscent of a bygone era. In the afternoon, we make our way to **Shifen**, where we partake in the magical tradition of releasing **sky lanterns**. This activity allows you to write your wishes on a lantern and watch it float into the sky, creating a memorable and picturesque moment. Next, our journey continues with a visit to the stunning **Shifen Waterfall**, often referred to as the "Little Niagara of Taiwan." As evening approaches, we return to Taipei, bringing with us memories of a day filled with cultural discoveries, natural wonders, and heartfelt moments.

DAY 3 TAIPEI (Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner)

After breakfast, start today at the Chiang Kai-Shek Memorial Hall, an iconic landmark dedicated to the former President of Taiwan. Next, visit the Taipei Grand Mosque, the largest and most important mosque in Taiwan. This elegant structure, with its distinctive green dome and minaret, stands as a symbol of religious diversity and harmony in the city. For the afternoon, head to the Wufenpu Shopping District, one of Taipei's most popular shopping areas. Conclude your day with a visit to Taipei 101 (Not included observation deck), one of the tallest skyscrapers in the world. The shopping center at the base of Taipei 101 offers a range of high-end stores and dining options.

DAY 4 TAIPEI – MIAOLI – TAICHUNG (Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner)

After breakfast, transfer to Miaoli. Here, you'll visit **Zhuoye Cottage**, a serene retreat known for its traditional blue-dye workshops. Engage in a hands-on DIY **blue-dye experience** where you can create your own indigo-dyed fabric. Next, head to the central city of Taiwan, Taichung. Your first stop is the **Zhong She Flower Market**, a stunning floral paradise that boasts a vast array of colorful blooms throughout the year. Next, continue to the **Gaomei Wetlands**. The wetlands are particularly famous for their beautiful sunsets, which cast a golden glow over the expansive mudflats and wind turbines. Tonight, you'll visit the famous **Fengjia Night Market**, one of the largest and most popular night markets in Taiwan.

Day 5 TAICHUNG – NANTOU – CHIAYI (Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner)

After breakfast, start your day in Taichung iconic, **Rainbow Village**. The vivid colors and imaginative designs make Rainbow Village a must-see destination, perfect for photography and appreciating the power of art to transform communities. Next, travel to **Nantou**, home to the stunning **Sun Moon Lake**.





This beautiful lake is named for its unique shape, with one part resembling a sun and the other a moon. Embark on a **boat tour** to fully experience the tranquil beauty of the lake. Next, continue your journey to the vibrant city of Chiayi, where you'll visit the bustling **Wenhua Road Night Market**. Wander through the lively stalls, sampling a variety of local delicacies such as oyster omelets, and bubble tea.

Day 6 CHIAYI - ALISHAN - TAINAN (Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner)

After breakfast, head to **Alishan National Scenic Area**. This mountainous region is famous for its breathtaking sunrises, ancient forests, and serene beauty. Take a tranquil walk around **Sister Ponds**, two picturesque bodies of water that are steeped in local legend. The reflections of the surrounding trees on the water create a serene and magical atmosphere, perfect for peaceful contemplation. In the afternoon, continue your journey with a visit to the **Yuyupas Tsou Tribe Cultural Village**. Participate in aboriginal traditional dances, listen to ancient songs, and learn about the tribe's customs and way of life. After a day of exploration, unwind at a Tainan hotel, where you can enjoy comfortable accommodations and reflect on the day's adventures.

Day 7 TAINAN - KAOHSIUNG (Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner)

After your breakfast, your first stop is **Anping Old Fort**, a historic fortress that dates back to the 17th century when it was built by the Dutch. Next, take a leisurely stroll through **Anping Old Street**, one of Tainan's most famous historical streets. Sample local delicacies and browse through unique souvenirs that reflect the area's rich cultural heritage. Continue your journey with a visit to the **Chimei Museum (exterior only)**, renowned for its impressive collection of art, musical instruments, and natural history exhibits. While you will primarily enjoy the museum's exterior for a photo opportunity, the stunning architecture and beautifully landscaped grounds provide a picturesque setting. Next, transfer to **Kaohsiung**, where you will visit the **Pier-2 Art Center**, a vibrant hub of contemporary art and creativity. Located in a repurposed warehouse district, the Pier-2 Art Center is home to galleries, studios, and outdoor installations that showcase the work of local and international artists

DAY 8 KAOHSIUNG – SINGAPORE (Breakfast/Meal on Board)

Enjoy a leisurely morning until it's time to gather for departure to Kaohsiung Airport and return to Singapore.
